Big Idea:

Matthew 5:4 God blesses those who mourn, for they will be comforted.

"Blessed are those who mourn what is wrong and unjust and sincerely repent, for God comforts those who suffer and those who truly repent." - Stassen & Gushee, Kingdom Ethics

1. <u>FACE IT</u>

- If I want to live in the blessing of His kingdom, I must face it sin separates me from this good (blessed/fortunate) life.
- Mourning others' sin is different than judging others' sin.
- I will experience God's blessing and know His comfort, when I mourn the sin I see in myself and others.

Psalm 51:1-3

¹*Have mercy on me, O God, because of your unfailing love. Because of your great compassion, blot out the stain of my sins.*

² Wash me clean from my guilt. Purify me from my sin.

³ For I recognize my rebellion; it haunts me day and night.

2. <u>FEEL IT</u>

- It's a WEIGHT that emanates from our deep in our gut.
- If I want to live in the blessing of His kingdom, I must feel the weight of sin.
- I will experience God's blessing and know His comfort, when I mourn the sin I feel in myself and others.

Psalm 51:8-10

⁸Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me – now let me rejoice.

⁹ Don't keep looking at my sins. Remove the stain of my guilt.

¹⁰ Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.

3. <u>FIND COMFORT</u>

• Comfort the brokenhearted

Psalm 34:18

The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; he rescues those whose spirits are crushed.

Psalm 51:12

Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you.

• When WE mourn, we are in the perfect place to encounter God's comfort in a lifechanging way. 2 Corinthians 1:3-4

...God is our merciful Father and the source of all **comfort**. ⁴ He **comforts** us in all our troubles so that we can **comfort** others...

4. <u>KEYS</u>

• The blessed life is not for us to hold on to; it's to experience His comfort in such a profound way that we can't help but share it with others.

Matthew 5:4
