

# When Grace Flows In, Gratitude Fills Up, and Generosity Flows Out

#### THE BIG IDEA:

**GENEROSITY** is the overflow of a heart filled with **GRATITUDE** when you receive the **GRACE** of GOD.

#### PEOPLE WHO ARE MORE GRATEFUL GET:

- 25% happier
- Better sleep
- Exercise 33% more
- 10% drop in blood pressure
- **Decrease dietary** fat intake by up to 20%
- (Studies compiled by Dr, Robert Emmons in *Gratitude Works*)

When one of the **Pharisees** invited Jesus to have dinner with him, he went to the Pharisee's house and **reclined** at the table. <sup>37</sup> A **woman** in that town who lived a **sinful life** learned that Jesus was eating at the Pharisee's house, so she came there with an **alabaster jar of perfume**. <sup>38</sup> As she stood behind him at his feet weeping, she began to **wet his feet with her tears.** Then she **wiped** them with her hair, kissed them and **poured perfume** on them. <sup>39</sup> When the Pharisee who had invited him saw this, he said to himself, "If this man were a prophet, he would know who is touching him and **what kind of woman she is—that she is a sinner**." **LUKE 7:36-39**
