

Walking in the Word Blessed Hope Rev. Andy Pursley December 1, 2024

Acts 4.7-12

⁷They had Peter and John brought before them and began to question them: "By what power or what name did you do this?" ⁸Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them: "Rulers and elders of the people! ⁹If we are being called to account today for an act of kindness shown to a man who was lame and are being asked how he was healed, ¹⁰ then know this, you and all the people of Israel: It is by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified but whom God raised from the dead, that this man stands before you healed. ¹¹Jesus is "'the stone you builders rejected, which has become the cornerstone.' ¹²Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved."

Here is the lesson Peter knows now:

If you want to be close to Jesus but attempt to blend into the crowd, you will more than likely deny the Lord when you are called out or questioned.

Why? How? Does he respond differently this time?

⁸Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them: "Rulers and elders of the people!

What is a Full Gospel Church? One that is empowered by the power of the Holy Spirit that believes and proclaims ALL THE GOSPEL: Jesus still saves, Jesus still fills, Jesus still heals, and Jesus is still coming.

1. <u>Jesus Still Saves</u>

¹¹ Jesus is "'the stone you builders rejected, which has become the cornerstone.' ¹² Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved."

1 John 1.9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

But keep in mind that Peter is preaching to a religious audience.

Yes, it is possible to lose your way as a follower of God.

Jesus is the missionary:

¹² Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved."

Jesus still Saves!

2. Jesus Still Fills

⁸Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel.

Do you remember the event when you were baptized in water?

Acts 4.29-31

²⁹ Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. ³⁰ Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus." ³¹ After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.

Power for Bold Witnessing.

Jesus still saves, Jesus still fills.

3. Jesus Still Heals

⁷They had Peter and John brought before them and began to question them: "By what power or what name did you do this?"

Healing is cemented in the gospel of Jesus Christ:

Direct Result of this healing:

¹⁴ And seeing the man who had been healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.

Philippians 2.9-10

Therefore God exalted him to the highest place

and gave him the name that is above every name,

- ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
- ¹¹ and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Jesus still saves, Jesus still fills, and Jesus still heals.

4. Jesus is still coming.

Acts 3.19-20

¹⁹ Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord, ²⁰ and that he may send the Messiah, who has been appointed for you—even Jesus. ²¹ Heaven must receive him until the time comes for God to restore everything, as he promised long ago through his holy prophets.

Here are the straightforward implications of the Blessed Hope:

- My bodily death here on earth, my spirit is immediately ushered into God's presence.
- The imminent return of Christ is that Jesus will return and rapture His Church.
- The world will then begin to see God's judgment.
- Jesus invites us into His work by calling us to make disciples of all nations.
